4. Alberta Labour Partnerships – Miranda McLay

- 2022 COR Auditing
 - Requirements for 2022 Audits:
 - documentation and interviews for both Certification and Maintenance
 - Overall, 80% (Certification) or 60% (Maintenance) requirement to pass, no minimums per element.
 - Observations continue to be optional for 2022
 - Action plan dates continue to be extended for the 2022 season
- Auditor Status
 - Requirement for auditor certification remains at 1 audit within the 3 year cycle
 - Must attend an auditor update
 - Auditor candidates and complete qualification audit that has documentation and interviews completed
 - Auditors with limited status have until December 31, 2022 to complete their second qualification audit
 - Starting January 2023, auditor requirements will be returning to pre-COVID standards

- Printing CORs
 - Partnerships no longer prints these, but AMHSA can.
 - Employers can now print their own COR through the WCB LCR portal
- COR and SECOR Updates
 - COR and SECOR audit criteria have been updated due to changes in legislation and use of the new standard over the last few years
 - New COR and SECOR tools are created
 - Updates to training courses and new audit tools must be implemented by AMHSA by January 1, 2023
- Auditor Notes
 - Standard was updated recently.
 - All questions require quantification.
- Key Changes to the COR Audit Criteria
 - Allowance of applicable legislation (Alberta or Federal) to be used to answer legislation questions
 - Hazard assessments reviewed on pre-determined frequency instead of regular basis
 - Reduction in # of questions around Violence and Harassment to simplify requirements
 - JWSHSC/R element updated to match new legislation requirements
 - Self-employed persons removed as now included under employer as per OHS legislation definition
 - Minimum requirements around cascade scoring of questions
- SECOR Adapted for Owners/Operators
 - A new definition for Owner/Operator was created with Certifying Partners and WCB
- 2022/23 OSAR Year
 - Target is 75 OSARS, 2 planned for AMHSA.
 - OSARs will be completed both on-site and off-site this year
- Miscellaneous Statutes Amendment Act
 - OHS Legislation Book was updated May 2022; Section 55(4) & 61.

- AMHSA Auditing
 - Special auditor update September 2022, re-modernization of COR program
 - Strategic Steering committee – CP. Labour, WCB
 - ISO 45001:2018 and CSA eligibility for COR
 - Working Groups:
 - Complexity Based and Scalable Audit
 - Auditor Qualification, Training and Certification
 - COR Harmonization and Measurement

 - Audit Refresher: January 31 or April 4
 - HSMS: February 7/8 or March 7/8
 - HS Auditing: February 21/21 or March 21/22

- January 1, 2023
 - Updated large (regular) employer COR Audit Tool launch and revised training
 - New SECOR Audit Tool launch (scored vs yes/no for AMHSA employers) and training
 - Revised auditor training
 - Council included in WCB Interviews
- 2023 Audit Plan – Draft
 - Partnerships monitoring COVID-19, will respond if public health measures are implemented.
 - Plan in effect January 1 – Dec 31, 2023
 - Onsite data gathering activities are not restricted
 - “Safe Auditing Guidelines for Auditors and Employers for On-Site Activities” is suspended
 - Techniques: Docs review and interviews: remote or on-site. Observations required, considering remote options for observations.
 - Cor Certification Audits: documentation, interviews, observations. 80% overall, no less than 50% in elements.
 - COR Maintenance Audits: documentation, interview, observations. 60% overall. Action plan maintenance option. PHS optional element.
 - Auditor Certification Maintenance: Attend Audit Refresher. Completed two audits.
 - Auditor Qualification: Training – HSMS and Auditing. Qualification Audit – 3 validation methods, 6 months.
