



Safety Recreation Facility Operator Certifications

Essential Knowledge for Keeping Your Facility Safe.

Program Overview

Alberta Association of Recreation Facility Personnel (AARFP) and Alberta Municipal Health and Safety Association (AMHSA) have partnered to offer four educational certification opportunities and technical skills related to the operation of recreation facilities. The four certification programs are: *Arena Safety Operator*, *Aquatics Safety Operator*, *Building Maintenance Safety Operator*, and *Parks and Sport Fields Safety Operator*.

What Are the Benefits?

- Enhance your skills and knowledge as a safety operator.
- Assists in professional development plans for your staff.
- Establishes an educational standard in which recreation facility employers use as a basis for hiring.



Arena Safety Operator

Students will learn a variety of tasks related to arena operations including the making, marking, painting and maintenance of artificial ice surfaces and refrigeration theory. AMHSA core and elective courses that focus on health and safety and legislative requirements are included.



Aquatics Safety Operator

Students will learn a variety of tasks related to swimming pool operations including water circulation/filtration, basic chlorine and salt water chemistry, water balance, pool diseases and water testing. AMHSA core and elective courses that focus on health and safety and legislative requirements are included.



Building Maintenance Safety Operator

Students will learn a variety of tasks to maintain and troubleshoot their facility components including HVAC, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, control systems, and suppression systems. AMHSA core and elective courses that focus on health and safety and legislative requirements are included.



Parks and Sport Fields Safety Operator

Students will learn a variety of tasks related to sport fields and parks maintenance including the maintenance of equipment, plant beds, soil tests, weed control, turf diseases, pruning, composting, irrigation, grass greens and tee boxes. AMHSA core and elective courses that focus on health and safety and legislative requirements are included.
